

## Distinct performance of kharif sorghum hybrid: CSH 25

A demonstration trial on newly released hybrid CSH 25 (*Parbhani Sainath*) was allotted to Shrimati Srikanya Rajendra Jadhav of Sripadwadi, taluka Ambejogai in district Beed of Maharashtra. She shared her experiences on performance of CSH 25 as below.

“I always use to take *kharif* hybrids like CSH 9 or hybrids of private companies. I was really impressed by cultivating hybrid CSH 25 on my field .I got 1950 kg of grain and 3500 kg of fodder from this one acre of land only (It yielded 4875 kg /ha of grains and 8750 kg /ha of fodder under the field trial). The panicle size was big with better quality grain as compared to crop grown by others farmers in the nearby plot. One of the important point to note that CSH 25 was free from aphids infestation and yielded enough fodder as well. I requested the scientists to supply me such type of hybrids in future. It can make sorghum cultivation profitable by yielding higher grains and fodder than other sorghum hybrids”.
